<b>Worship</b>	Multiplatform in-person/online. Sanctuary divided into spaced seating areas. Number allowed set by distancing requirements. Doors remain open.	Multiplatform in-person/online. <b>Music</b>	Choir members must be vaccinated and masked. No congregational singing.	Choir members must be vaccinated and masked. Masked Singing Allowed.	Masked Singing Allowed.
<b>Nursery &amp; Childcare</b>	Nursery aged children are encouraged to play outside with families on Sunday, but no childcare is provided.	Nursery room is available for 6 people, or 3 families, whichever is a less number. Doors and windows open.	Nursery open. Childcare for events available at staff discretion following best available current recommendations.
<b>Children &amp; Youth/Small Groups</b>	Small groups are encouraged to meet online or outside. Lead consent conversations about meeting online or outdoors/indoors and making physical contact.	Small groups are encouraged to meet online or outside. Inside space at 50% capacity, or groups of 10 or less with open windows. Lead consent conversations about meeting online or outdoors/indoors and making physical contact.	Groups allowed with open windows.
<b>Food</b>	Food only allowed outdoors. Individual servings.	Food only allowed outdoors. Individual servings or 1-3 people serving food following protocols.	Food only allowed outdoors. Potlucks allowed as long as masks are worn during serving.
